State Large Group Speech Contest: February 7th 2015 at Valley West High School in West Des Moines

- 5:10 am All Speech students loaded on bus at high school
5:20 am BUS LEAVES TREYNOR – you miss the bus, you miss your performance!
7:30 am Arrive at Valley High School in West Des Moines, set up “camp”
ALL DAY Perform, Watch and Embrace the Thespian Enthusiast in you!

What you should **bring** with you:

- Costume OR dress outfit that is appropriate for performance, check with coach before contest day if you’re unsure what to wear – DO NOT WEAR “Treynor” GEAR to perform in!!!
- Props – Scripts – Projection equipment for short film or TV News – Mime signs - ANY supplies your group uses in a performance!
- Speech T-Shirt, if you ordered one, to wear when NOT performing. *If you’re watching Treynor performances PLEASE tape over the word “Treynor” on your shirt. Mrs. Burton will have tape in the ballot box at “camp”.
- Money! We have performances until 2:30 in the afternoon, you will want food and you will not be allowed to leave contest to get food elsewhere. They will also be selling IHSSA t-shirts and sweatshirts if you’re interested in one.

What you should **do** at contest when not performing:

- Meet with team to practice your performance
- Watch and support other Treynor group’s performances
- Watch other groups in your category perform, some will be worse than your own and others will be better, you can learn a lot from both!

What to do **if leaving with a parent/guardian** from contest (rather than on the bus):

- You AND your parent/guardian will need to check out with Mrs. Burton before leaving Audubon High School
- Only your own parent/guardian can drive you home after your performance UNLESS you have previously approved another ride home with Mr. Navara and Mrs. Burton. Arranging to ride home with a friend’s parent or other family member the day of contest will not be allowed.
