Nomination Petitions must be signed by 23 eligible electors of the Treynor School District.

The deadline to file the Affidavit of Candidacy and Nomination Petitions with the Treynor School District's Office Manager is Thursday, August 25, 2016 at 5:00 PM.

## Request Absentee Ballot

Requests for Absentee Ballots are available:

On-line at the Iowa Secretary of State
At the Office of the Pottawattamie County Auditor – 227 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Council Bluffs, IA
At Treynor Schools Office Manager's office – 102 E. Main, Treynor, IA

The request form must be received by the County Auditor's office by 5 p.m. on Friday, September 16, 2016.

The County Auditor will mail the ballot as soon as they are ready.

The auditor will include instruction on how to mark the ballot as well as how to return the ballot.

### Returning the Ballot

You can return your voted absentee ballot by mail. Return deadlines and instructions will be mailed with the absentee ballot.

Voted absentee ballots cannot be delivered to the polling place on Election Day. If you have not returned your absentee ballot on Election Day, you have the following options:

- 1. Deliver your voted absentee ballot to the county auditor's office before the polls close on Election Day.
- 2. Surrender your voted absentee ballot at the polls and vote a regular ballot, or
- 3. Vote a provisional ballot at the polls if you cannot surrender your voted absentee ballot.
