

ASSIGNMENT OF COURSES

Students shall take a predetermined number of and types of courses to graduate. Where students have a choice in course offerings, the school district will try to allow each student to take the course of his/her choice. Courses with limited space will be allocated to those who first apply for the course or need it for graduation.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to develop the course offerings for each year for the grade levels. The superintendent shall make a recommendation to the board annually as to which courses shall be offered.
