EARNING A GRADE

- A: Always can do it

HOMEWORK

- Daily work is equivalent to music/athletic/speech/etc practices.
 You get out what you put in.
- Every assigned problem is to be completed. Don't skip "difficult" ones.
- All work needs to be shown for each problem.
- Test questions come from homework problems.
- Accounts for 25% of total grade

TESTS

- Come from homework problems (occasionally numbers or symbols switched)
- Advanced notification before each test (~4-5 days)
- 1-2 per Chapter
- Worth 75% of grade
- To be finished in class (no staying after or coming back)
- Retakes are not allowed

ABSENT WORK


- Absentee work follows school policy (1 extra day)
- You are responsible for getting notes you missed

ABSENT WORK (SCHOOL EVENT)


LATE WORK



DAILY PROCESS


- Enter class and be seated

CLASSROOM PROCEDURE


WHILE YOU'RE IN CLASS
