Superintendent Beyenhof presented Virtual Learning plans for 2023-2024.

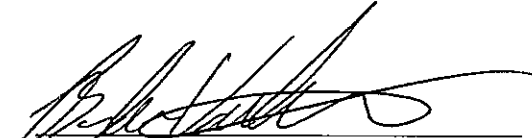
Next Meeting
