BOARD OF DIRECTORS' ELECTIONS

The school election takes place on the second Tuesday after the first Monday in November of oddnumbered years. Each school election is used to elect citizens to the board to maintain a five-member board and to address questions that are submitted to the voters.

Citizens of the school district community seeking a seat on the board must file their nomination papers with the board secretary, or the board secretary's designee, between seventy-one (71) and forty-seven (47) days before the school election unless otherwise directed.

If a vacancy occurs on the board, it shall be filled in accordance with law and board policy.

It is the responsibility of the county commissioner of elections to conduct school elections.
