

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION

Students utilizing school transportation will conduct themselves in an orderly manner fitting to their age level and maturity with mutual respect and consideration for the rights of the school vehicle driver and the other passengers. Students who fail to behave in an orderly manner will be subject to disciplinary measures.

The driver will have the authority to maintain order on the school vehicle. It is the responsibility of the driver to report misconduct to the building administrator.

The building principal will have the authority to suspend transportation privileges of the student or impose other appropriate discipline for inappropriate behavior.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent, in conjunction with the building principals, to develop administrative regulations regarding student conduct and discipline when utilizing school district transportation.
