

DOING BUSINESS WITH CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS

The board and the district do not want to do business with individuals who have committed crimes against children. Specifically, if the board becomes aware of an individual who has pleaded guilty to or has been convicted of a crime against a student, age 18 or under, then the board may take action to not have a business relationship with that individual. This policy does not require the district to conduct any screening or research *per se*. However, confirmed, reliable information shall serve as a basis for action under this policy. Upon the board's voting by a majority vote to cease and desist doing business with an individual, it shall be the responsibility of the superintendent and administration to enforce this policy.
