Check-In / Bag Check-In

Prom kids only in Check-In area. Please enter in West Gym High School doors. Visitors enter through Auditorium doors. Kids will proceed to picture taking stations in Commons and Auditorium once they are checked in and formal pictures have been taken.

• IF YOU ARE ATTENDING PROM ONLY, upon arrival at Parade of Stars, check in and proceed to pictures.

• IF YOU ARE ATTENDING ALL PROM ACTIVITIES INCLUDING POST PROM, upon arrival at Parade of Stars, you will need to check your bag.

•**ONE** bag per person. Preprinted labels will be available for you to tag your own bag. Parent volunteers will be available to assist you with this process.

- Your bag should contain a comfortable change of clothes for post-prom, hangers, protective bags for gowns/tuxes and all personal items you will need for post-prom.
- No food or drink allowed in the bags and may be thrown away.
- The bags will be searched upon check in by a designated security team.
- You will <u>not</u> have access to your bag until returning to school from the dance.
- YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GO TO YOUR CAR AT ANY TIME DURING THE PROM / POST PROM ACTIVITIES.
