- ATTENDING ALL PROM ACTIVITIES INCLUDING POST PROM
 - Students currently in middle school grades 6th-8th grade or individuals over the age of 20 are not permitted to attend Treynor Prom activities. ▪ Check in your bag prior to proceeding to photo stations.
- Only Prom attendees are allowed to check in bags at arrival.
 - Prom attendees will check in ONE BAG per person attending post prom.
- Labels will be available for you to tag your bag.
- Parent volunteers will be available to assist you with this process.
- Bags should contain a comfortable change of clothes for post prom, hangers, protective bags for dresses/tuxedos, and all personal items you will need for post prom.
- NO food or drink allowed in the bag- It will be thrown away.
- Bags will be searched at check-in by an officer and security.
- You will not have access to your bag until returning to school on the buses from the dinner/dance.
 - Proceed to the photo stations in the East Gym.
- If prom attendees need/want to carry a small purse to the prom dinner/dance, they may do so after having it inspected and cleared by security.

YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GO TO YOUR CAR AT ANY TIME DURING THE PROM/POST PROM ACTIVITIES.

Photo Stations 3:00 P.M to 4:30 P.M.

- Formal posed pictures by Tracy Gillespie Photography will be provided for those that have turned in the form and payment. These will be done before the Parade of Stars at her photo station.

- It is suggested that the photography form and payment be returned by March 26th along with the other forms.

Parade of Stars 4:30 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.

The Junior Class would like to invite you and your guest, and your family to the Treynor Parade of Stars and Prom Coronation beginning at 4:30 P.M. in the High School Auditorium.

- Junior and Senior students, along with their guests, will be introduced at the Parade of Stars under the spotlight.
- The coronation of the Prom King and Queen will follow the introduction of all prom attendees.
- Tracy Gillespie will also take photos during the Parade of Stars in the auditorium. These will be free to download at a later date.

Class Pictures 6:00 P.M.

- Class group pictures will be taken at the conclusion of the Parade of Stars before loading onto the buses. Location of picture TBA.

Travel to and from Palace Event Center 6:20 P.M. and 10:00 P.M.

- Travel will be provided to and from the Palace Event Center via Treynor Community School buses. You will not be allowed to drive yourself.
- Should you leave the dinner/dance for any reason, you will not be allowed to return nor attend post prom activities and your parents will be notified.

Dinner/Dance 6:30 P.M. to 10:00 P.M.

- The dinner and dance will be held at the Palace Event Center.
- Dinner/dance attendance is required in order to attend all other prom activities. In case of extenuating circumstances, you will need to talk with a school administrator to override this policy.
- You will receive a separate invitation from Ms. Abbott and the Junior Class with the important prom details.

Post Prom 10:15 P.M. to 1:00 A.M.

- Activities such as Inflatables, Paint Room, Poker Room, Henna Station, Animal Encounter, Movie Room, Caricatures, Corn Hole Tourney, Dodge Ball and Basketball.
- Variety of food and drinks.

Change of Clothing

- You will be allowed time to change once you arrive back at school after the dance.
- Changing will be done in designated locker rooms.
- Please hang your formal wear up.
- Your bag will be left in the locker room, you will be responsible for collecting your personal bag and formal wear after the Post Prom activities. We nor the school are responsible for lost or stolen items.

Disclosures

- Junior parents and other volunteers will be conducting and chaperoning the post prom event. Please be respectful and courteous to them.
- Once you arrive at the school, you will not be allowed to exit the building until the conclusion of the post prom activities.
- If a student leaves post prom early, parents will be notified.
- In case of an emergency, parents will be notified.
- All doors will be monitored. If anyone leaves the building, they will not be allowed to return to the events, and parents will be notified.
- If a student or person accompanying a student is caught with alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or firearms, law enforcement officials will be contacted. This and all other rules of the THS Student Handbook are strictly enforced while at this event.

All students and guests are required to turn in the completed forms in order to attend and participate.

All forms are due by March 26th at 3:30 P.M.

There will be a prom box in the Treynor HS Office where you can return all completed forms.

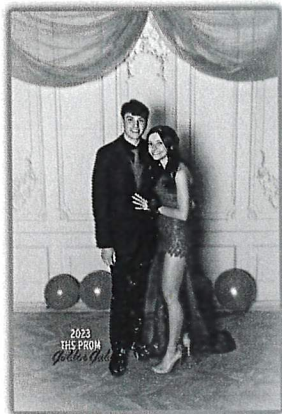
